



PSSR INSPECTION: What you need to know

As a business owner, you have a legal obligation to ensure that your workplace is safe for your employees and visitors. This includes ensuring that the machinery and equipment used on-site are maintained in good working order and are safe to operate.

The PSSR inspection ensures that you are meeting your legal obligation to comply with the Pressure Systems Safety Regulations (2000) in the United Kingdom. These regulations require that any equipment that uses pressurised systems, such as coffee machines, are maintained and inspected to prevent accidents and ensure safety.

Failure to comply with these regulations can result in fines or legal action, as well as potential harm to your employees and visitors. In addition to meeting legal requirements, conducting a PSSR inspection on your coffee machine also protects your visitors and team from accidents that can occur when machines are left unmaintained.

Failure to have your machine PSSR checked every 14 months will invalidate your liability insurance, leaving your business exposed to potential financial risks. Failure to comply with this requirement may leave you without coverage in the event of an incident.
